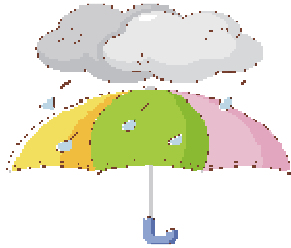

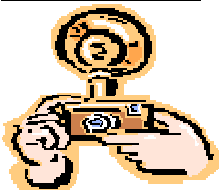
We are awaiting confirmation of two new staff members.

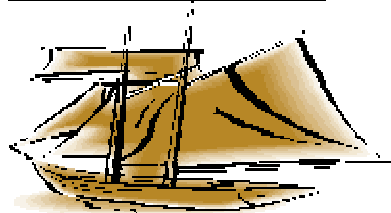

Primary 1 will visit the 'Tall Ship' berthed on the Clyde in front of the 'Riverside Museum'. Details to follow.

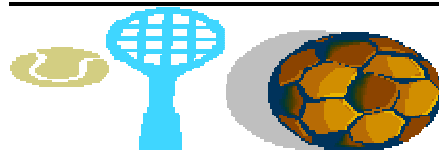
