Numeracy:

Building on what your child has learned in Nursery, you can continue to encourage your child to count everyday objects. Use the language that they will hear in Primary School e.g. How many cards, toys, shoes?

Do you have **enough/not enough** plates/cups/spoons, etc. **More or less**. – Who has more cars? Who has less crayons?

Continue to talk about daily routines, e.g early, late, before, after. Use actual Time language e.g School starts at 9 o'clock. Continue to say the names of the days and months and use a calendar/diary e.g Day to start school, date to go to the Dentist. Point out analogue and digital clocks.
